On Tuesday – The Inauguration of the Governor and Cabinet – over 3,000 plus Floridians and guests crowded the Capitol steps to witness the 2nd inauguration of Governor DeSantis and members of the Cabinet – Jimmy Patronis, Ashley Moody, and newly elected Ag. Commissioner Wilton Simpson. That evening guest descended on the Tallahassee Civic center for the Inaugural Ball.

Florida's D.E.M. Chief will Seek Disaster Preparation and Response Changes

Division of Emergency Management Director Kevin Guthrie will ask the legislature to consider changes to Florida Emergency Response requirement including the following items:

- Reducing the amount of time people have to remove damaged boats from waterways
- Providing uniform requirements for local governments about debris-removal contracts.
- Shielding from public records the names of people harmed by disasters.
- Requiring local governments to have pre-storm contracts that cover all aspects of debris removal.

Committee Chairman Sen. Ben Albritton, R-Wauchula, called the proposals "logical and thoughtful," adding that "Different parts of the state have different challenges."
