#### The Local Government Financial Information Handbook - the 2022 edition

The Florida Legislature's Office of Economic and Demographic Research (EDR) has published the 2022 edition of the *Local Government Financial Information Handbook*. This report serves as a reference for many of the revenue sources available to local governments. It contains descriptions of revenue sources, adjusted 2021 population estimates used in the FY 2022-23 state revenue-sharing calculations, estimated FY 2022-23 county and municipal government distributions for select state revenue-sharing and local option tax sources, and the 2023 local option fuel, sales, and tourist-related tax rates by county. # Florida Child Well-Being Index ranks the 67 Florida counties

A new report from the Florida Policy Institute shows the state has not made much progress when it comes to improving outcomes for children's health and education. The 2022 Florida Child Well-Being Index ranks the 67 Florida counties based on data from the national Kids Count project. It compares child well-being on 16 indicators in the areas of Economic Well-Being, Education, Health, and Family and Community. On a statewide basis, Florida was in the lower half nationwide, coming in at 35th for the third straight year.
