

- TRANSGENDER TREATMENTS Thursday, 2:45 p.m. Carrying out a new law, the Joint Rules and Legislative Committee of the Florida Board of Medicine and the Florida Board of Osteopathic Medicine is slated to discuss rules about treatments for transgender minors and adults. The Republican-controlled Legislature and Gov. Ron DeSantis this month approved a law

(SB 254) that bars doctors from providing treatments such as puberty blockers and hormone therapy to transgender minors. The law included an exception for minors who had already started the treatments, but it required the Board of Medicine and the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to approve rules that would spell out standards for the care. The law also created a new requirement for doctors to get "informed consent" before providing treatments to transgender adults. The Westshore Grand, 4860 West Kennedy Blvd., Tampa.
