What to Expect After You Apply for FEMA Assistance

FEMA Applications for Idalia Relief .docx

If you live in Charlotte, Citrus, Columbia, Dixie, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Hernando, Hillsborough, Jefferson, Lafayette, Levy, Madison, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, Sarasota, Suwannee or Taylor counties and were affected by Hurricane Idalia, FEMA may be able to help with temporary housing expenses, basic home repairs or other essential disaster-related needs that are not covered by insurance.

Bills Pre-filed for consideration in the 2024 Session

Bills Pre-filed for the 2024 Legislative Session - 10-7-23.docx

As of today, there have been 109 bill filed for consideration during the upcoming 2024 Legislative Session. There are two that jump out:

HB 0057 County Commissioner Term Limits by Salzman

County Commissioner Term Limits: Establishes term limits for county commissioners. Effective Date: July 1, 2024 This is a proposed change in statute – and will not require a vote of the public.

HB 0109 Conversion Charter Schools by Andrade

Conversion Charter Schools: Revises requirements for application for conversion charter school; authorizes municipalities to apply for conversion of specified public schools to charter schools; & authorizes Charter School Review Commission to solicit & review applications for conversion charter schools. Effective Date: July 1, 2024 - This proposal will allow Cities to apply to govern a Conversion Charter School and makes other changes to the approval process.

Senate Committees Scheduled for Oct. 10 and 11

The Senate is scheduled for two days of committee meeting next Tuesday and Wednesday – October 10 and 11. Times for Senate committee meetings have been published. No agendas yet!

House and Senate to Meet Week of Oct. 16

The Florida House and Senate are slated to hold their first full week of committee meetings in mid-October as they prepare for the 2024 legislative session. Schedules posted on the House and Senate websites show time set aside for four days of meetings during the week of Oct. 16. That includes time slots Oct. 16 for two new House panels — the Select Committee on Health Innovation and the Select Committee on Hurricane Resiliency & Recovery.


