Tornado Watch #708 is in effect for the following counties: Alachua, Baker, Bradford, Citrus, Clay, Columbia, Dixie, Duval, Flagler, Gilchrist, Hernando, Hillsborough, Lafayette, Lake, Levy, Manatee, Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas, Putnam, Seminole, St. Johns, Sumter, Suwannee, Taylor, Union, and Volusia.


