## State Board of Education Meeting Next Week at Destin High School

## Items of Interest:

- Update on Classroom Teacher and Other Instructional Personnel Salary Increase Allocation Section 1011.62(14)(c)2., F.S., requires each school district to submit to the Department an approved district salary distribution plan, along with the approved salary distribution plan for each charter school in the district, by October 1 of each fiscal year. An update will be provided on the department's review of district salary plans and districts' charter school salary distribution plans that were due by October 1, 2024.
- Identification of High Demand Teacher Needs Areas for 2025-26 Section 1012.07, F.S., requires the State Board of Education (SBE) to annually identify High Demand Teacher Needs Areas based on the recommendations of the Commissioner of Education. Rule 6A-20.0131, F.A.C., specifies that the list of high-demand areas identify high-need content areas and high-priority location areas.
- Approval of Turnaround Plans for the School Districts of Bay, Escambia, Madison, Pasco and Polk County

#### **Delegation Hearings**

Over two dozen legislative delegation hearings were held this week throughout Florida. Over 20 were insmall counties. Local Officials presented local priorities that will be requested and outlined other issues of importance to local communities.
